PARENTAL COMMITMENTS

1. We appreciate the standards of the school and do not tolerate profanity, obscenity in word or action, dishonor to the Trinity and the Word of God, or disrespect to the personnel of the school. We hereby agree to support all regulations of the school in the applicant's behalf and authorize this school to employ such discipline as it deems wise and expedient for the training of our child.
2. We understand that our failure to report psychiatric counseling, any prescribed program of medication, or involvement with juvenile authorities during the past three years may be cause for immediate dismissal.
3. We give permission for our child to go on field trips arranged by the teacher and approved by the administration. These educational trips will be properly supervised, and our child will be covered by his/her own school insurance program. We will not hold the school, administration or faculty responsible in case of accident.
4. We pledge our fullest cooperation to keep doctrinal controversy and denominationalism out of the school at all times.
5. We agree that, if our child should become involved in any trouble with other children in the school, we will, in the love of Christ and with prayer, register necessary complaints with the teachers or principals.
6. We understand that assessments will be made to cover damages to the school, including breakage of windows and abuse of other personal property.
7. We understand that the school reserves the right to dismiss any student who does not: 1) respect and observe spiritual and/or behavioral standards and 2) cooperate in our educational goals.
8. We understand that payments are due on the first of each month and become delinquent if not received by the 10th. If a quarter ends while an account is delinquent, the student will not be accepted for the next quarter until payment has been made or an arrangement for payment has been made.
9. In the event that our child becomes ill or sustains an injury while in the care of Riverside Christian School, we give our permission to those in charge to take whatever steps are necessary. If it is not possible to reach the child's doctor or to receive instructions for his/her care, consent is given to any licensed physician to administer drugs or medicines and perform such surgical procedures as he shall deem the existing emergency requires for the relief of pain and to preserve his/her life or health.
10. We understand that the school personnel hold a commitment to each family to be of any help possible in cooperating with the family in the academic, social and spiritual nurture of each child.
11. We agree to uphold and support the high academic standards of the school by giving our child encouragement in the completion of any homework or assignments.
12. We agree to demonstrate a commitment to the local church by regular attendance and involvement.
13. We agree to sign a Financial Payment Agreement, understand the terms stated in this application and agree thereto.
14. We agree to abide by the terms of the Service Hour Commitment Form, which we completed and signed at the time of application for admission.
15. We understand and agree that continued enrollment and re-enrollment of our children in Riverside Christian School is dependent on our parental support of the school, its staff, and its policies.
16. We have read the school's "Mission Statement", and furthermore, we agree to support all school policies and regulation. We are committed to the above "Parental Commitment."

STATEMENT OF FAITH

1. **Scriptures:** We believe in the Scriptures of the Old and New Testaments as verbally inspired by God, inerrant in the original writings and that they alone are the infallible Word of God. They alone are of supreme and final authority in faith and life.
2. **God:** We believe there is one, and only one, living and true God and that He eternally exists in three equal persons: Father, Son and Holy Spirit.
3. **Jesus Christ:** We believe that Jesus Christ is both true God and true man. We believe that as God, Jesus Christ exists from eternity to eternity as the Son of God. We believe that as man, Jesus Christ was begotten by the Holy Spirit and born of the virgin Mary. We believe that the Lord Jesus Christ died for our sins according to the Scriptures as a representative and substitutionary sacrifice; and that all who believe in Him are justified on the grounds of His shed blood. We believe in the resurrection of the crucified body of our Lord, in His ascension to heaven, in His present life there for us as High Priest and Advocate. We believe in “that blessed hope,” the personal imminent return of our Lord and Savior, Jesus Christ.
4. **Holy Spirit:** We believe the Holy Spirit eternally exists as the third person of the Triune Godhead. We believe that the Holy Spirit convicts men of the need for Christ and regenerates them, giving every believer a new spiritual life. We believe the Holy Spirit seals, empowers, guides, teaches and sanctifies every believer. We believe the Holy Spirit sovereignly bestows gifts upon believers and produces spiritual fruit in each Christian as evidence of a Spirit-filled life.
5. **Man:** We believe that man was created in the image of God; that he voluntarily sinned and thereby incurred not only physical death, but also spiritual death, which is separation from God; that all human beings are born with a sinful nature and are totally incapable, through any personal act or combination of actions of righteousness, to earn approval from God, which will solve the separation problem.
6. **Salvation:** We believe that salvation is available to all who will receive it and is wholly of grace through the work of the Lord Jesus Christ alone. All who receive this gift are born again of the Holy Spirit and thereby become children of God. Faith in the Lord Jesus Christ is the only condition of salvation. We believe that all who are born again are kept by God the Father for Jesus Christ.
7. **Resurrection:** We believe in the bodily resurrection of the just and unjust, the everlasting blessedness of the saved and the everlasting conscious punishment of the lost.
8. **Church:** We believe in the great commission, which our Lord has given to His church to evangelize the world, and that the church is made up of all who truly believe on the Lord Jesus Christ. The local church is a congregation of believers who have associated for worship and fellowship.
9. **Creation:** We accept the *literal* Genesis account of creation and believe that man came by direct creation of God and not by evolution.
10. **Satan:** We believe in the personality of Satan, that he is the unholy god of this age, the author of all the powers of darkness and is destined to the judgment of an eternal justice in the lake of fire.
